The County requires that all applicants submit a Construction Waste Management Plan for each project that will generate waste or unused materials at its conclusion. The intent is to comply with **State Law** by **diverting a minimum of 50%** of non-hazardous debris from landfills.

Your CDWMP will identify the applicable material types and the actions that will be taken to divert construction and demolition debris from landfills. **Part One** is due prior to building/demo permit issuance. **Part Two**, along with recycling/disposal documentation shall be submitted prior to final inspection.

- Residential additions and alterations in which the livable space increase in size **\$150.00**
