

## Opportunities

**Park Worker** Functions and duties will vary at individual parks and may include grounds and equipment maintenance, greeting the public, general clean-up, as well as other activities specific to the park.

**Trail Volunteer** Trails are served by volunteers who walk, bicycle, and ride horses on our trails. Volunteers will assist with the repair of minor storm and use damage, as well as the removal of trash, debris, and overgrown brush.

**Camp Host** Camp host duties vary according to each park, but generally include greeting visitors, answering questions and receiving comments, and being generally available to assist the public during their camping visits. Most hosts work about 20 hours a week and are provided a campsite during their stay in exchange for their services.

**Park Docent/Naturalist** These volunteers lend their specific interests and expertise to lead hikes, tours, and provide interpretive programs at the parks and historic sites.

**Youth Volunteers** Students, scouts, and other volunteers under 18-years-old are encouraged to talk to us about public service and volunteer work or ideas for completing a required project. Special projects, tree plantings, and trail maintenance are just a few of the opportunities we provide, but always like to hear how our youth volunteers would like to play a part in the progress of our parks.
