STRUCTURAL PEST CONTROL BUSINESS REGISTRATIONS

Registration for Structural Pest Control Operators in San Bernardino County expires on **December 31**. Renew your registration prior to performing pest control by following the appropriate procedure below.

IF YOUR COMPANY WILL BE PERFORMING BRANCH 1 FUMIGATION IN ADDITION TO BRANCH 2 AND/OR 3, SEPARATE REGISTRATIONS AND FEES ARE REQUIRED.

BRANCH 1 - FUMIGATION

Registration forms must be completed and submitted along with a check for **\$25**. List **ALL** company locations that will perform work in San Bernardino County. List the names of **ALL** Operators and Field Representatives that will be performing fumigation, the licensees' license numbers, and the principal (PR) or branch (BR) license number for each office. **PLEASE BE SURE THAT THE FORMS ARE COMPLETELY FILLED OUT.**

BRANCH 2 and/or 3

Registration forms must be completed and submitted along with a **\$10** check. List all company locations that will do work in San Bernardino County. List the Qualified Manager for each location, the licensee's license number, and the principal (PR) or branch (BR) license number for each office. **PLEASE BE SURE THAT THE FORM IS COMPLETELY FILLED OUT.** If the company is licensed in both Branch 2 and 3, only one registration form and \$10 fee is required.

PESTICIDE USE REPORTS

You may now submit your pesticide use reports via the web-based system that you can access at www.calagpermits.org. E-mail us at awm@awm.sbcounty.gov for a user ID and password in order to submit reports to San Bernardino County. **Proof of your registration can be viewed on your home page of the calag permits program.**

BUSINESS REGISTRATIONS***

Registration for Agricultural Pest Control Operators in San Bernardino County expires on **December 31**. Renew your registration prior to performing pest control by following the appropriate procedure below.

AGRICULTURAL PEST CONTROL OPERATORS

You must complete the registration form and provide us with your current and valid Qualified Applicator License (QAL) card, a copy of your State of California Agricultural Pest Control Business License, an equipment list (if power equipment is used), and a check for **\$75**. **RESTRICTED MATERIALS PERMITS WILL BE ISSUED IN PERSON ONLY, UNLESS WAIVED BY THE PESTICIDE ENFORCEMENT DIVISION.**

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REGISTER BEFORE RECEIVING YOUR NEW ID CARDS AND STATE BUSINESS LICENSES FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PESTICIDE REGULATION (DPR).

MAINTENANCE GARDENERS

You must complete the registration form and provide us with your current and valid Qualified Applicator Certificate (QAC) card, a copy of your State of California Maintenance Gardener Pest Control Business License and a check for **\$25**. PLEASE NOTE - **RESTRICTED MATERIALS PERMITS CANNOT BE ISSUED TO MAINTENANCE GARDENERS WITH A QUALIFIED APPLICATOR CERTIFICATE WITH CATEGORY O.**

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REGISTER BEFORE RECEIVING YOUR NEW ID CARDS AND STATE BUSINESS LICENSES FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PESTICIDE REGULATION (DPR).

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RESTRICTED MATERIALS PERMIT & OPERATOR ID RENEWAL

Many Restricted Materials Permits and Operator ID Numbers in San Bernardino County expire on **December 31**. **PLEASE CHECK THE EXPIRATION DATE ON YOUR PERMIT BEFORE COMING INTO ONE OF OUR OFFICES.** Renew your permit/operator ID # prior to performing pest control by following the appropriate procedure below.

RESTRICTED MATERIALS PERMITS

A Private Applicator Certification examination is required for **ALL** growers wishing to apply restricted materials. **You must provide color satellite maps of all site locations every year.** If your wallet-size brown Private Applicator Certificate card is still valid, bring it with you in order to renew your Restricted Materials Permit; otherwise, you are required to pass (with 70%) a written examination. A “Pesticide Safety Reference Manual” (in English or Spanish) for growers is available for **\$7**. A Qualified Applicator Certificate (QAC) or License (QAL) is required for all government agencies, golf courses, etc. wishing to apply restricted materials.

OPERATOR IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS

A Private Applicator Certification examination is not required for growers wishing to apply non-restricted materials. **You must provide color satellite maps of all site locations every year.** However, any employees who handle pesticides or who are field workers are required to receive training from a qualified trainer. If you, as a grower, intend to perform the training, then you will need Private Applicator Certification. A “Pesticide Safety Reference Manual” (in English or Spanish) for growers is available for **\$7**. A Qualified Applicator Certificate/License card is not required for government agencies, golf courses, etc. wishing to apply only non-restricted materials.

PESTICIDE USE REPORTS

You may submit your pesticide use reports via a new web-based system that you can access at www.calagpermits.org. E-mail us at awm@awm.sbcounty.gov for a user ID and password in order to submit reports to San Bernardino County.
