### ***VISION IN ACTION AWARDS***

Plans are underway to bestow the first annual Vision in Action Awards at the 2013 SANBAG General Assembly on June 20. A committee of County, SANBAG, and County Superintendent of Schools staff is developing the criteria for the awards and the selection process. The awards will recognize individuals and entities that have made a significant impact toward collaboration and achieving the Countywide Vision's two Regional Implementation Goals:

- Partner with all sectors of the community to support the success of every child from cradle to career
- Establish San Bernardino County as a model in the state where local government, regulatory agencies and communities are truly business friendly

### ***BEST PRACTICES SURVEY***

On March 14, SANBAG sent a Best Practices survey to city, town and County planners, engineers, and other staff who interface with those who submit building and development plans. The response deadline was April 5, 2013. The plan is to share the survey responses with the business community. The project is part of the effort to achieve the "business friendly" Countywide Vision Regional Implementation Goal.

### ***UPCOMING COG PRESENTATIONS***

SANBAG continues to develop its role as a Council of Governments with two presentations related to achievement of the Countywide Vision:
