Hello –

Thank you for your interest in serving on the 2012-2013 San Bernardino County Grand Jury. Enclosed is the application material you recently requested. Before submitting the application it may be of some help to you to understand what is involved and how the Grand Jury is selected.

Applications will be screened by Superior Court Judges. Those individuals whose applications and/or subsequent interviews reveal that they possess the knowledge, skills and abilities to perform the duties of a Grand Juror will be considered. Because a large number of applications are received, many qualified individuals will not be nominated. A letter will be sent to all applicants not selected.

The law requires the Superior Court judges nominate not more than 30 or fewer than 25 persons as prospective Grand Jurors. Six nominees are selected from each of the five County Supervisorial Districts. The persons selected will constitute the Grand Jury Panel and they will be summoned to appear in court at a date and time designated in the Summons. You must be present for this selection process (usually the last week in June). The names of the persons who actually appear in response to the Summons are placed in the jury wheel, and 19 names are then drawn. The 19 individuals so selected will constitute the Grand Jury for the ensuing fiscal year commencing July 1, 2012.

The Grand Jury is essentially an investigative body. The Grand Jury has three basic investigatory responsibilities: 1) To investigate and report on the functioning of local government including the county, special districts and cities; 2) To hear evidence and determine whether there is sufficient cause to indict individuals suspected of crimes; and 3) To investigate reports of willful or corrupt misconduct of public officials and, and to present an accusation where appropriate. Historically, the main focus of the San Bernardino County Grand Jury has been the investigation of county government; performing a "watchdog" function on behalf of the county citizens. This investigatory function requires Grand Jurors to interview county officials and employees, visit county facilities and agencies, draft investigative reports, and publish a final grand jury report containing findings of fact and recommendations.

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Service on the San Bernardino County Grand Jury can be a full time job for one full year. San Bernardino County, with its large population and vast geographical expanse, as well as numerous facilities, agencies and departments throughout the County, has become so complex that members of the Grand Jury must be prepared to devote their time and energy almost totally to the needs and demands of this activity.

Three days per week are the minimum number of days worked. However, often Jurors will work four and even five days a week. **It is essential that all Grand Jurors be in attendance and only the most pressing emergency or a Juror's illness should be reasons for absence. Vacation time off should be kept to a minimum.**

Recognizing the period of service and the rigorous schedule of the Grand Jury, prospective Grand Jurors should be in **good to excellent health**. Ability to go on field trips is essential for gathering information and investigation purposes.

Grand Jurors are compensated for attendance at general sessions, committee meetings and assignments at the rate of \$25.00 per day. Mileage expense is compensated at the IRS allowable rate for each mile actually and necessarily traveled for purposes of said sessions or committee work. The Grand Jury meets in the city of San Bernardino.

If you wish to apply for possible service on the 2012-2013 San Bernardino County Grand Jury, please complete the enclosed application form and statement of qualifications; a resume is strongly recommended.

Thank you for your interest in becoming a member of the 2012-2013 San Bernardino County Grand Jury.

The attached "Statement of Qualification" and "Application" must be completed in their entirety and returned to the Grand Jury Office no later than **February 29, 2012**. If any information is omitted, the entire form will be returned to you.

Please be sure to read all the documents enclosed. Also it is important to understand the commitment and dedication of a Grand Juror. The work week is a minimum of three days and can be full five days per week. The hours will vary, but they can range from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. There, of course, are lunch hours and breaks.

The Grand Jury is comprised of 19 people who work together very closely on many projects. Grand Jurors are involved with meetings, committees, research, investigations, interviews and the writing of reports. Each member is required to be a part of and make contributions in each of these areas.

Although it is not a disqualification, it is recommended to not be employed while serving on the Grand Jury. Service on the Grand Jury is an extremely important commitment and can be quite involved and time consuming. Being employed at the same time is, at best, difficult.

I am aware that service on the San Bernardino County Grand Jury is for a twelve-month period beginning July 1 through June 30 of the following year and that such service may require my attendance three days, and possibly up to a five days, per week. Reasonable absences (up to 12 days) are permitted.

I am also aware that I may be requested to participate in an orientation program for up to two weeks in the month of June. It must be understood there is not any provision under the law for compensation for the orientation program.

I am further aware that as compensation for my duties as a Grand Juror, I will be paid \$25.00 for each day of service and roundtrip car mileage at the current rate. Parking is provided.

I hereby state that I am capable of carrying out my duties as a member of the Grand Jury and that I have no plans for extended vacation, travel, or business (more than 12 business days) which would prevent me from serving the required amount of time.
