The San Bernardino Superior Court is looking for interested county citizens who want to:

- ✓ Become Involved
- ✓ Promote Sound Government

With the following qualifications:

- ✓ At Least 18 Years of Age
- ✓ A Citizen of the United States
- ✓ Minimum One-Year Resident of San Bernardino County
- ✓ Sufficient Knowledge of the English Language
- ✓ Good Health, Good Character and Sound Judgment

The Civil Grand Jury is charged by the State Penal Code to investigate all aspects of County, City and Special District Government, and to hear information on certain criminal investigations.

The Civil Grand Jury usually works 3 – 5 days per week, beginning July 1 and ending the following June 30. Jurors are given \$25 per diem each day worked as well as mileage and parking. The Grand Jury meets in San Bernardino.
