**SYNOPSIS:** \*revised

On Monday, 09/08/2014, \*Nola Taylor's son drove her home to Joshua Tree after leaving Desert Regional Medical Center in Palm Springs, CA. After returning home, Taylor left the same day driving her car in route to her quilting class at the Yucca Valley Community Center. Taylor never made it to her class and her vehicle was later discovered by the sheriff's department on Friday, 09/12/2014, after her son reported her missing. Taylor's tan 1989 Lincoln Continental was located disabled in the city limits of 29 Palms on Desert Quail Drive and Baseline Road, at which time the sheriff's department started an immediate search of the area utilizing patrol personnel, sheriff's aviation, sheriff's blood hounds, and search and rescue; however Taylor was not located.
