	<p><b>Option House Inc.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Gloria presented an overview of the services they offer including peer counseling, parenting classes, and incarceration prevention. The program has a 32-bed shelter for all victims of Domestic Violence in San Bernardino County. She shared that they are working with hospitals as a referral source.</li> <li>- The organization offers a teen violence prevention program in both junior high and high school, providing information about recognizing unhealthy relationships and roots of violence, among other topics.</li> <li>- The program offers a 20-week physical battery program.</li> <li>- They are currently operating in eight locations including Central Juvenile Hall San Bernardino, Norco State Prison, Glen Helen, and West Valley Detention Center.</li> <li>- They are in need of additional funding for their work in the prisons.</li> </ul>	Gloria Amaya
