**SUBJECT: SAND AND SAND BAGS**

---

The following inventory of sandbags and sand at our fire stations is identified for consistency and flood preparedness. This information will be passed down to County Flood Control and County Fire Public Information Officers for distribution to the public and the press. As other information is up-dated on county policies this list could change. As of today, the following needs to be available.

Each station needs to keep an inventory of bags with the exceptions of stations 11, 16, 19, 21, 34, 37, 38, 43, 44. PCF stations not within any of the flood areas should maintain a minimum of 250 bags. These are stations 56, and 57.

All other stations need to maintain a minimum of 1000 bags. Stations with sand available need to maintain 2000 bags. Stations may pass out as many as 25 bags to local residents to help with water/flood issues. If storm drains (street drains) are clogged County Flood Control needs to be contacted to deal with the water/flooding issue. (Public Works/Flood Control is not allowed to work off the road right of way.) Sand bags are available to order on our on-line ordering catalog.

If sand is needed, contact myself or Gary McCord to arrange deliveries. Preplan to allow 3-5 days for the sand delivery.
