X. Presentation: California's new Green Building Codes-Bambi Tran: New Effective January 1, 2011, newly constructed buildings will be required to develop a waste management plan and divert at least 50 percent of the construction materials generated during the project (2010 Green Buildings Standards Code [CALGreen] Sections 4.408 and 5.408). Local jurisdictions with an existing C&D diversion ordinance can choose to amend its ordinance or inform stakeholders in some manner, e.g., when they apply for their building permit. CALGreen is based on the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED standards (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design).

Bambi Tran is a LEED Accredited Professional who consults to developers, architects, contractors and building owners; and conducts green building and LEED training. She will provide an overview of CALGreen and its recycling impacts.
