Commuter Information

Since 1960, the number of miles Americans travel to work each year has more than tripled. According to a report by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), greenhouse gas emissions from transportation went up nearly 25 percent between 1993 and 2003. We are still driving to work alone in our cars, contributing to highway congestion and global warming.

Shifting away from the one-person car commute would be a terrific way to cut carbon emissions, save oil and gas, and get to work more relaxed. The County offers a variety of programs to assist County employees in meeting their ridesharing goals.
