


Airshow Safety Information/Concerns

Safety is key for all attendees of the 2015 Chino Airport Airshow. The Department of Airports requests to ensure a safe and pleasurable experience to be had by all and are requesting the following safety concerns be adhered. To ensure that all of your guests that attend and enjoy their time at the show, we are having each party apply for a certificate to ensure a responsible party is available to oversee proper safety concerns. Post the certificate clearly for proper identification.

1. The hangar leasee/permittee is ultimately responsible for all their guests whether invited or not.
2. Maintaining a clear access for emergency ingress/egress is paramount, no party or gathering shall impede more than 15 feet outside the footprint of their hangar.
3. Parking of any guests **must** be in an orderly fashion and not impede any other hangars or emergency access.
4. Any non-street legal vehicles with the exception of golf carts will **not** be permitted to operate within the boundaries of the Airport.
5. All grills must be outside of the hangar to meet Fire Regulations.
6. Any bounce house must be clearly separated from operating generators.
7. There will be no access to the roof on County owned facilities and an agreement must be in place for any non-County owned facilities.
8. All street-legal motorcycles being operated must meet California DMV rules and regulations including wearing a DOT approved helmets.
9. Access to the show display area is restricted to Planes of Fame Airshow ticket holders.
