JUDGMENT GRANTING PERMANENT INJUNCTION; MAPS 1 & 2 (OF SAFETY ZONE)

Assigned for all purposes to the Honorable Donald Alvarez, Judge

Default having been entered against Defendant COLTON CITY CRIPS December 10, 2008, the above-entitled cause came on regularly for court trial concerning defendant LAWRENCE WHITE on May 18, 2010, in Department S36 of the above-entitled court, before the Honorable Donald Alvarez, judge presiding, sitting without a jury. MARK A. VOS appeared as attorney for Plaintiff, THE PEOPLE, and THOMAS A. BRACKEY and DEREK S. LEMKIN appeared for defendant, LAWRENCE WHITE. Oral and documentary evidence having been introduced, the cause submitted for decision, and the Court having made and filed its written Statement of Decision, Judgment is entered for Plaintiff as follows:

JUDGMENT GRANTING PERMANENT INJUNCTION AGAINST COLTON CITY CRIPS & LAWRENCE WHITE

1 **FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN**, it is hereby ordered that this PERMANENT
2 INJUNCTION issue against COLTON CITY CRIPS criminal street gang, an
3 unincorporated association, and against defendant LAWRENCE WHITE, a natural
4 person. The permanent injunction shall be effective within the "SAFETY ZONE."

5 **"SAFETY ZONE" IS DEFINED AS FOLLOWS:** (Two maps of the proposed
6 SAFETY ZONE are attached as exhibit **MAPS 1 and 2**, and are incorporated herein by
7 reference.) The entirety of the Arbor Terrace Apartment complex at 2170 N. Rancho
8 Ave., Colton, CA 92324, including sidewalks and curbs bordering it, and extending
9 east 150 yards from its eastern boundary to include the unimproved greenbelt area
10 behind it. The entirety of the SB Liquor store, inside and out, and its surrounding
11 property, located at 484 S. Rancho Ave., San Bernardino, CA, 92410, including its
12 parking lot, the alley behind it, all sidewalks and curbs bordering it, and the
13 unimproved area to its south, extending to Mill St. and including the sidewalk and
14 curb there. The segment of Chestnut St. in San Bernardino, including curbs and
15 sidewalks on both the north and south sides, extending from Iris St. on the west, to
16 Rancho Ave. on the east. The parking lot, sidewalks and curbs of Lucky Plaza located
17 at 2100 N. Rancho Ave., Colton, CA, 92324, nestled between the northeast corner of
18 Rancho Ave. and Mill St., and the southeast corner of Arbor Terrace Apartment
19 complex, and the spaces behind the structures to the north and to the east. The
20 parking lot, sidewalks and curbs of Lucky Coin Laundry and its shopping center,
21 located at 2035 W Mill St. San Bernardino, CA 92410, including the spaces behind the
22 structures to the south and to the west. The parking lot, sidewalks, and curbs of the
23 Stater Brothers shopping center at 1904 Rancho Ave., Colton, CA, 92324, and the
24 spaces behind that shopping center to its south and to its east. The parking lot,
25 sidewalks, and curbs of the Sierra Vista Baptist Church, 2300 N. Rancho Ave. Colton,
26 CA, 92324. The segment of Rancho Avenue, including sidewalks and curbs on both its
27

1 east and west sides, from the northern boundary of Sierra Vista Baptist Church,
2 extending southward to and including the intersection at Rancho Ave. and Mill St.
3 The unimproved "greenbelt" area, beginning at the northeastern corner of the Sierra
4 Vista Baptist Church lot, extending due east 150 yards, then following a line southeast
5 to Mill St., maintaining and including a 150-yard buffer behind Sierra Vista Baptist
6 Church and then behind Arbor Terrace Apartments at 2170 N. Rancho Ave., Colton
7 CA 92324.

8 ACTS PROSCRIBED WITHIN THE SAFETY ZONE are as follows:

9
10 a) Concerning COLTON CITY CRIPS WHO DO NOT RESIDE at Arbor
11 Terrace Apartments

12 COLTON CITY CRIPS, all of its members, and all persons acting under, in
13 concert with, for the benefit of, at the direction of, or in association with
14 COLTON CITY CRIPS, who are not lawfully and contractually-approved
15 residents of Arbor Terrace Apartments located at 2170 N. Rancho Ave. in
16 Colton, are prohibited from being present in or at, passing through, or
17 stopping anywhere in or at Arbor Terrace Apartment complex, (including its
18 appurtenant curbs, sidewalks, and unimproved space adjacent to or
19 surrounding it), whether inside or outside of buildings, and whether on foot as
20 a pedestrian, or whether on or in a vehicle of any sort including motor vehicles,
21 bicycles, skates and skateboards;

22 b) Concerning SB Liquor and All COLTON CITY CRIPS

23 COLTON CITY CRIPS, all of its members, and all persons acting under, in
24 concert with, for the benefit of, at the direction of, or in association with
25 COLTON CITY CRIPS, are prohibited from being present in or at, passing
26 through, or stopping anywhere in or at SB Liquor Store at 484 S. Rancho Ave.,
27 San Bernardino, (including its appurtenant curbs, sidewalks, and unimproved
28

1 space adjacent to or surrounding it), whether inside or outside of buildings,
2 and whether on foot as a pedestrian, or whether on or in a vehicle of any sort
3 including motor vehicles, bicycles, skates and skateboards;
4

5 c) **Concerning All Colton City Crips Within the Entire SAFETY ZONE**

6 1. Appearing in public or walking or riding together, in groups of two or
7 more, with other members or associates of COLTON CITY CRIPS, or with
8 members or associates or affiliates of any other criminal street gang,
9 including, but not limited to, members of "Pimps, Players, Hustlers and
10 Gangsters", or PPHG, criminal street gang;

11 2. While present in the SAFETY ZONE, recruiting, helping or encouraging
12 any person to join COLTON CITY CRIPS or any of its subsets or offshoots
13 such as Zoo Babies, or the like;

14 3. Selling, possessing, using or being under the influence of any controlled
15 substance or related paraphernalia, without a valid prescription from a state
16 licensed physician or practitioner;

17 4. Remaining in the presence of anyone selling, possessing, using, or being
18 under the influence of any controlled substance or related paraphernalia
19 without a valid prescription from a state licensed physician or practitioner;

20 5. Possessing, displaying, or transferring money proceeds from the sales of
21 controlled substances or weapons;

22 6. While present in the SAFETY ZONE, informing other persons that
23 controlled substances can be purchased at Arbor Terrace Apartments (or the
24 "Zoo"), or can be purchased from COLTON CITY CRIPS, its agents and
25 associates;

- 1 7. While present in the SAFETY ZONE, informing other persons how or
2 where they can purchase controlled substances unlawfully, or from whom,
3 or for what price;
- 4 8. Demanding, receiving or paying "taxes" (money commission) to other
5 gang members or associates or to anyone else for the "privilege" of selling
6 controlled substances in the SAFETY ZONE;
- 7 9. Drinking alcoholic beverages in public, being under the influence of
8 alcohol in public, possessing open containers of alcoholic beverages in
9 public, or driving while under the influence of alcohol;
- 10 10. Possessing, selling, transferring, abandoning, or discharging firearms,
11 ammunition, explosive devices, or possessing, selling, transferring,
12 abandoning, any other weapons made unlawful by the Penal Code or by
13 other statute or ordinance;
- 14 11. Gambling, or possessing, displaying or transferring gambling
15 paraphernalia or money proceeds from gambling;
- 16 12. Loitering and loitering to sell illegal drugs;
- 17 13. Standing on, sitting on, or otherwise occupying the outdoor stairs at
18 Arbor Terrace Apartments;
- 19 14. Stopping, standing or lingering on the walkways, in the breezeways,
20 throughways, and stairwells of Arbor Terrace Apartments;
- 21 15. Blocking the free passage of any person or vehicle on any street,
22 walkway, sidewalk, driveway, alleyway, breezeway, throughway, stairwell,
23 or other area of public passage;
- 24 16. Being present in the laundry room at Arbor Terrace Apartments when
25 any other member of COLTON CITY CRIPS or associate or other gang
26 member is present, or lingering there other than to do one's laundry;
- 27

- 1 17. Abandoning contraband;
- 2 18. Littering;
- 3 19. Vandalism;
- 4 20. Trespassing;
- 5 21. Committing assault or battery;
- 6 22. Disturbing the peace;
- 7 23. Inciting, encouraging or participating in a fight, or in any violent gang
- 8 activity such as "jumping in";
- 9 24. Obstructing, resisting, or delaying police in the performance of their
- 10 duties by fleeing when police approach, by warning others when police
- 11 approach, by acting as "lookout" against police, by lying to police, by
- 12 giving a false or incorrect name and identifying information, by resisting
- 13 arrest, or by any other means;
- 14 25. Entering any apartment or building to hide or flee from police or
- 15 apartment security;
- 16 26. Using electronic devices to warn others of police investigation or of
- 17 police approach;
- 18 27. Lying to, misleading, or not cooperating with Arbor Terrace Apartments
- 19 security personnel or other employees or agents, including lying about
- 20 one's true name, age, identity, gang affiliation, criminal record, or about
- 21 material terms of lease agreements;
- 22 28. Covering one's face to conceal identity from police, from Arbor Terrace
- 23 Apartments personnel, or from Arbor Terrace security cameras;
- 24 29. ~~Fostering the reputation, by photography, by video, by depiction on the~~
- 25 ~~internet, in any audio recordings, any verbal or written form, or by any~~
- 26 ~~other means, that Arbor Terrace Apartments and SB Liquor are the "turf"~~

1 of, home to, territory of, or belong in any way or degree, past or present, to
2 COLTON CITY CRIPS, or to its subsets or offshoots such as "Zoo Babies,"
3 or "Zoo Crew," or the like;

4 30. Commemorating the formation of COLTON CITY CRIPS or any
5 associated criminal street gang by holding a "hood day" celebration or by
6 holding a similar gathering or party;

7 31. While present in the SAFETY ZONE, bribing, encouraging, threatening
8 or intimidating others to cooperate with, or not to oppose, or not to report
9 to law enforcement, or not to testify in court about, the crimes and nuisance
10 activities of COLTON CITY CRIPS and their associates;

11 32. Entering any vacant or abandoned apartment or structure at Arbor
12 Terrace Apartment complex;

13 33. Entering any apartment at Arbor Terrace Apartment complex where any
14 member or associate of COLTON CITY CRIPS resides or is present;

15 34. Driving, entering, riding in, parking, or being present in any vehicle in
16 the parking lot at Arbor Terrace Apartment complex unless that member of
17 Colton City Crips legitimately resides at Arbor Terrace Apartments and the
18 vehicle is lawfully present;

19 35. If under the age of 18, being in a public place between 10:00 p.m. and
20 sunrise the following morning, consistent with City of Colton's juvenile
21 curfew ordinance. (Colton Municipal Code 9.32.010);

22 36. If eighteen years old or older, being in a public place between midnight
23 on any day and sunrise the following morning, unless involved in an
24 emergency, employment, school, or religious activity;

25 37. Applying graffiti to any property, public or private;

38. Possessing any graffiti tool in a public place, including any marking pen, spray paint, or sharp object capable of scarring glass, metal, concrete, or wood;

39. Displaying publicly any gang-related tattoos;

40. Displaying gang signs or symbols in public, including but not limited to gang hand signs, gang attire and ornaments, and Colton City Crips' strut called the "C-Walk";

41. Inquiring about or demanding to know any other person's gang membership or affiliation.

42. Intimidating, harassing, threatening or retaliating against any person involved in this gang injunction action.


d) Concerning Mr. Lawrence White

1. No term of this injunction order is intended to abridge Mr. Lawrence White's commercial, free-speech rights while he is not present in the SAFETY ZONE.


