defendant(s) Adrian Powers has been convicted of a crime with a Penal Code section 186.11 enhancement;

the crime is not punishable pursuant to Penal Code section 1170(h)(3).

COUNT 6

On or about January 5, 2011, in the above named judicial district, the crime of ACCESSORY AFTER THE FACT-(KNOWLEDGE OF CRIME), in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 32, a felony, was committed by Jose Ramon Lara, who unlawfully, having knowledge that the crime of Murder, a felony, in violation of Section 187(a) of the Penal Code of the State of California had been committed by Anthony Legaspi, did harbor, conceal, and aid said Anthony Legaspi, with the intent that he/she might avoid and escape from arrest, trial, conviction, and punishment for said felony.

It is further alleged pursuant to Penal Code section 186.22(b)(1)(A) as to count(s) 6 that the above offense was committed for the benefit of, at the direction of, or in association with a criminal street gang with the specific intent to promote, further or assist in criminal conduct by gang members.

"NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require you to register pursuant to Penal Code Section 186.30(a). Willful failure to register is a crime."

It is further alleged that pursuant to Penal Code section 1170(h)(3) defendant(s) Jose Ramon Lara is eligible for imprisonment in the state prison due to:

- the current charge is a serious or violent felony;
- defendant(s) Jose Ramon Lara has a prior serious or violent felony conviction;
- defendant(s) Jose Ramon Lara has been convicted of a crime with a Penal Code section 186.11 enhancement;
- the crime is not punishable pursuant to Penal Code section 1170(h)(3).
