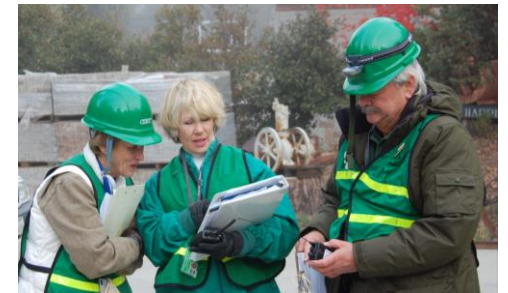
Organized teams of CERT trained volunteers all over San Bernardino County have already made the commitment to be prepared.
