2021 AGRICULTURAL PESTICIDE PERMIT RENEWAL

Renew your permit (Restricted Materials or Operator Identification) prior to applying any pesticides in 2021.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL PERMITS:

NEW: Issuance of 2021 permits will start on November 2, 2020. No 2021 permits will be issued before this date.

NEW: All 2021 permits will be issued out of the San Bernardino office between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

NEW: You are highly encouraged to call the San Bernardino office at (909) 387-2105 to schedule an appointment for your permit issuance.

RESTRICTED MATERIALS PERMITS

A Private Applicator Certificate (PAC) wallet card that is **valid until at least 12/31/2021** must be presented if you or your direct employees apply the pesticides yourself on your own property.

If a Pest Control Business performs your pesticide applications, you must still get a Permit for your property.

(Note: government agencies, golf courses, etc., applying restricted materials must have a QAL/QAC holder on staff.)

OPERATOR IDENTIFICATION PERMITS (OpID)

Private growers who apply only non-restricted materials will receive an OpID permit. A PAC is not required.

(Government agencies, golf courses, etc., applying only non-restricted materials do not require a QAL/QAC holder.)
