We are currently compiling statistics that will determine the total value of agricultural commodities in San Bernardino County for 2020. In 2019, the total value of agricultural commodities in San Bernardino County was \$384,223,000. This was determined by information obtained from growers within the county. Please take a moment to fill out the attached Crop Report Questionnaire. The information that you provide is essential to the completion of the annual Crop Report. The Crop Report helps guide policymakers regarding agriculture and provides researchers with reliable and statistical information regarding the volume and variety of agricultural commodities located within the county. Additionally, the information you provide will help educate the public about the agricultural commodities grown within the county and help determine where San Bernardino County ranks in California and the nation in agricultural production.

The commodity values that are shared are anonymous and the Crop Report Questionnaire is kept confidential and will be used solely for the purpose of compiling relevant annual commodity statistics and will be unavailable to any other agency. In order to ensure confidentiality, commodities produced by three or fewer growers will be incorporated into the miscellaneous categories for their commodity groups.

Please complete and return only one questionnaire. If you are no longer in business, but grew crops in San Bernardino County in 2020, please still report your crop values for the year.
