2020 AGRICULTURAL PESTICIDE PERMIT RENEWAL

Renew your permit (Restricted Materials or Operator Identification) prior to applying any pesticides in 2020.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL PERMITS:

NEW: Issuance of 2020 permits will start on December 2, 2019. No 2020 permits will be issued before this date.

NEW: All 2020 permits will be issued out of the San Bernardino office between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

NEW: You are highly encouraged to call the San Bernardino office at (909) 387-2105 to schedule an appointment for your permit issuance.

NEW: Unfortunately, no 2020 permits will be issued out of the Ontario or Hesperia offices.

A current, COLOR, "satellite view" map of each one of your individual site locations must be provided per California Code of Regulations §6428(c). The maps must be clear enough to show surrounding land uses.

Monthly Pesticide Use Reports are required of all permittees and should be submitted online using the Cal Ag Permits website (www.calagpermits.org). If you are not able to access the Cal Ag Permits website, contact our office.

There is no fee for Restricted Materials or Operator Identification permits.

RESTRICTED MATERIALS PERMITS

A Private Applicator Certificate (PAC) wallet card that is **valid until at least 12/31/2020** must be presented if you or your direct employees apply the pesticides yourself on your own property.

If a Pest Control Business performs your pesticide applications, you must still get a Permit for your property.

(Note: government agencies, golf courses, etc., applying restricted materials must have a QAL/QAC holder on staff.)

OPERATOR IDENTIFICATION PERMITS (OpID)

Private growers who apply only non-restricted materials will receive an OpID permit. A PAC is not required.

(Government agencies, golf courses, etc., applying only non-restricted materials do not require a QAL/QAC holder.)
