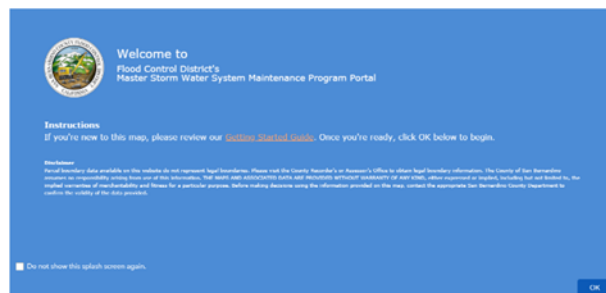
Question: How do I access the Draft EIR?

Answer: Either copy and paste the following hyperlink into your browser, or press Ctrl and right-click <http://cms.sbcounty.gov/dpw/PublicNotices.aspx#24615> . Then click on link to the San Bernardino County Master Storm Water System Maintenance Program, then click on the San Bernardino County MSWSMP DEIR.pdf to open a PDF copy of the Draft EIR.

A hard copy is also available at most local libraries throughout the County.

Question: How do I find the maintained flood control facility closest to my home?

Answer: Click on the Flood Control District Interactive Map hyperlink above. Click OK on the welcome and disclaimer screen.

Next enter your address or Assessor's Parcel Number into the search bar labeled "Address, APN, or Facility" and press enter. You can then zoom in or out of the map to view the closest flood control facility that is routinely maintained. The maintained flood control facility will be shown in red or pink.

Question: Will the County hold any workshops or public hearings on the adequacy of the EIR?

Answer: The Flood Control District is tentatively planning two public workshops, one in the Victorville area and one in the Valley to overview the Draft EIR and its conclusions. Notifications of the workshop dates, time, and locations will be announced shortly on the Flood Control District website.

A Public Hearing on the adoption of the EIR and its findings will be conducted after the 45-day comment period. Notification of the Public Hearing date, time, and location will be announced at a later date.
