Dear Homeowner:

Enclosed is a "Uniform Handling Exemption Request" for July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. In order to qualify for an exemption, you must submit:

- A Completed application and a \$15.00 **non-refundable** processing fee along with \$85.14 for a San Bernardino County Disposal Use Permit for a total of \$100.14 for each residence you are applying **AND EITHER**
- For repeat applicants, three (3) sets of four (4) consecutive weekly disposal receipts (Monday-Saturday), for each residence you are applying for, from an approved solid waste facility, **OR**
- For first time applicants, one (1) set of four (4) consecutive weekly disposal receipts (Monday-Saturday) for each residence you are applying for, from an approved solid waste facility.

Valid Exemption requests received on or before June 30, 2019 will be effective on July 1, 2019. Valid exemption requests received after June 30, 2019 will not be effective until the first date of the next hauler billing cycle. For example, applications received between July 1, 2019 and September 30, 2019 will be effective October 1, 2019. Applications will be accepted beginning April 1, 2019.
