



GENERAL OVERVIEW

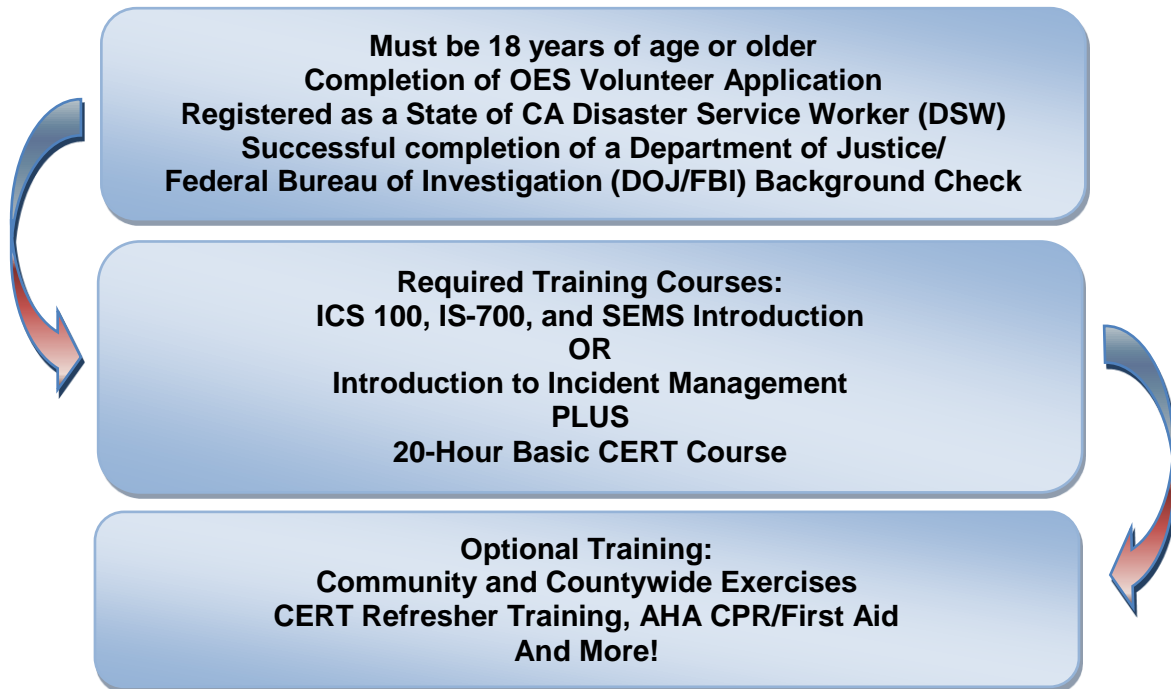
Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) is one of four volunteer groups under the Fire Corps Program administered by the San Bernardino County Fire, Office of Emergency Services. Each community program is assigned a CERT Fire Liaison to administer the operational responsibilities and work hand-in-hand with their CERT Volunteer Coordinator.

CERT volunteers are expected to properly learn and conduct tasks that will support their community and the Fire Department during a major disaster. CERT volunteers also support the emergency management mission of preparedness and public outreach.
